

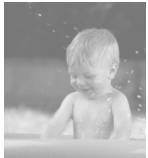

**Aqua-Play:
water acclimation (6-48 months)**

This is a wonderful class designed to orient you and your child to our facility and give you a glimpse of what we offer in our Aquatics program. This is a great opportunity for parent and child to be in the water together learning water safety and adjustment while sharing quality time through songs and games.

This class is offered Monday & Wednesday evenings or Tuesday & Thursday mornings.



**Toddler Swim Lessons:
Sea Stars (12-24 months)
Sea Turtles (24-48 months)**

Our Toddler Swim Lesson program takes Aqua Play to the next level, turning into actual lessons for parent and child. In the course of each session we go over many basic skills such as water adjustment, cueing, breath control, entry and exit from the pool, and, of course, safety skills and parent education. Children and parents use a variety of toys and equipment to make learning fun and interesting!

Our classes are divided into two age groups so participants can get the most out of this program. The “Sea Stars” class is our one year old group, and the “Sea Turtles” class is for our two year olds.

Our program features a child-centered approach where we will introduce basic skills to each child and they will progress only when they are comfortable with the current skills being taught. We do not force children to participate in activities that they are not mentally, emotionally, or physically ready for - we always let them proceed at their own pace because we want everyone to love the water as much as we do!

This class is offered Tuesday and Thursday evenings.

The YMCA has been teaching and developing swim lessons for over one hundred years! Here at the YMCA of Greenville, we follow that tradition by offering a wide variety of aquatic programs, but maintain a personal relationship with each individual.

In the Parent/Child Program, the child has a teacher who is also the most trusted person in their life, their parent. The instructor acts as the facilitator and will train you as a parent to become the child’s teacher and coach. Our instructors use a child-centered approach to training your child that will allow a child to feel secure while exploring the new world of swimming.

While the Aqua-Play program is designed to help the child become comfortable in the water, the 8-class series in the Toddler Swim Lessons attempts to teach your child how to swim on their own. These classes will meet frequently to help the child quickly become comfortable in the water.
