**\$140.00 per week**  
**And a \$50 Registration Fee**

At registration you will be required to pay a \$15 deposit for each week you register your camper. This is to hold your child's space. Both the \$15 deposit and the registration fee are non-refundable. Payments are due the Thursday prior to the week your camper will attend Teen Camp.
